Kim's Korner

A look at prayer from a research prospective:

In the book ***The Power of Prayer on Plants***, the author, Rev. Franklin Loehr, wrote that he heard Ernest Holmes, who was one of the participants in the research project, tell an advanced prayer class, "You don't have to wait till you feel like it to pray. Two plus two equals four whether you feel like it or not!" Ernest Holmes is telling us in that statement that prayer is not at the mercy of our moods. It's a movement in mind that is based on provable science. All that is required on the part of the person praying is belief and an intention to be a channel of healing.

Rev. Loehr states that, "Our research first established the fact that prayer is an objective energy, real in itself and not just a state of mind. Prayer is a force that can make a difference in the way seeds sprout and grow. Then we discovered that prayer seems to be an energy complex, a composite of a least four kinds of power - mental, emotional, physical and spiritual."

The final result of the prayer experiment showed documented proof that prayer impacts the core structure of plants. The plants that were prayed for grew faster, were healthier, and they produced seeds that carried the impact of prayer into the next plant generation. All in all it is a very good recommendation for daily prayer.
